

# Maitland High School Years 9 & 10, 2022 Book and Stationery Requirements

Below is a list of the books and stationery that each student will need to start the year.

- Pencils 2B: Mathematics, Visual Arts
- 2 x USB 4GB Flash Drive
- Colour Pencils
- Glue, scissors, eraser, sharpener with case
- Set of 4 highlighters
- 30cm ruler
- Pens black, blue and red
- Leather covered shoes compulsory for ALL practical lessons

All books should be covered, clearly displaying the student's name and year.

Dear Parents/Carers,

If your child has elected a Technology or Food based subject in 2022, they will be undertaking substantial practical work throughout the year. This means working with materials and equipment that can be hazardous if students are not wearing the correct protective equipment. For this reason, when purchasing new shoes, we would like you to purchase school shoes that meet the WHS requirements of the course and thereby reduce the risk of injury.

Students who are not wearing protective leather upper shoes in 2022 **will not** be permitted to do practical work. These students will be given alternative theory work and if the situation is not corrected the student may not be able to meet the skill and practical components of the course. Students in non-compliant footwear impact on the proper and efficient operation of practical classes by taking up valuable teacher time.

My aim in this letter is to give you accurate and timely information about proper footwear. It is critical to note that canvas shoes and ballet style flats are not acceptable.

**Extract from current DEC policy** "It is mandatory that students carrying out practical activities using chemicals or equipment in schools wear enclosed leather footwear"

The shoes below ARE suitable and meet WHS (OH&S) requirements at Maitland High School because;

· they have leather uppers,

- · there are NO punched holes or mesh.
- · they are NOT canvas, and
- they cover the <u>upper part</u> of the foot.

These shoes **are not**suitable for practicals as
they are only PARTIALLY
suede
